

Plant Healthcare Program

Have you ever wondered what affects the health of your plants? Most of the factors which contribute to plant health are unseen because they are found underground in the soil.

As discussed on our previous newsletter article "Got mulch?"; the soil has its own ecosystem with an array of micro-



organisms that work together to decompose organic matter and aid in nutrient cycling, which is essential to proper <u>plant health</u>.

Soil in urban environments can be extremely heterogeneous due to soil being moved during construction and other processes which do not occur in nature. There are <u>many stressors</u> in urban soils which plants are not adapted to deal with, and from which can lead to plant health problems.

At Arborist Now, we can help you assess the health of your plants or shrubs and try to localize the causes of stressed plants whether it be nutrient deficiencies in the soil or infestation by <u>pests or diseases</u>. Most of the time it will be a combination of factors which can be treated simultaneously to re-invigorate your plants.

Some common pests and diseases that you may be familiar with are <u>aphids</u>, <u>mites</u>, scales, powdery mildew and leaf spot. Many of these pests take advantage of plants previously stressed by other factors. Arborist Now can help you manage these pests, and the root cause of the infestation, by providing you with a *seasonal program* that fits your needs whether it is monthly or annually.


